Telemedicine

Telemedicine is the use of electronic information and communication technology to get healthcare you need. All you need is phone or device with internet to continue your medical care while protecting yourself and your healthcare provider from coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), and saving much time for your businesses.

In the recent few years telemedicine has become more acceptable and is present in more than 125 countries, even though in the past, telemedicine has got challenges and some resistances despite a great potential. With COVID-19 pandemic of 2020 however, the usefulness of telemedicine and care have become more evident worldwide.

The new world order caused by COVID-19 has brought telemedicine to centre stage of our healthcare. Applicable and acceptable by the health community and industry, it is desirable and much sought after by many patients. In fact, the elegant fitness between telemedicine qualities and some of the barrier measures of COVID-19, that are social distancing, decrease of contact with health facilities, other patients and healthcare staff, has raised telemedicine to a place of honour in a world threatened by this current pandemic.

As previous pandemics have impacted humanity, comparable with wars, revolutions or economic crises, the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic is thought to make a sustained and responsible change in our behavior and attitude to shape a new mankind: 2020-n Man.
